### Contraindicated Drugs in Parkinson Disease Patients

The term "contraindicated" means that the drug in question cannot be given to a patient. In individuals with Parkinson disease, the basic problem is the chemical nature of the disease itself. Many drugs alter the brain's dopamine system. Several of these drugs are used for non-neurologic conditions, and providers may not be familiar with their potential to alter the symptoms of Parkinson disease. Every patient with Parkinson disease should have a list of these agents available for their physician's reference.
